

## Background

- WMO Memorandum of Understanding signed 1998
- Initial term of five years with OBS (Equant)
- Several contract extensions and service upgrades
- ECMWF TAC subgroup to plan beyond 2010
- Three-phases:



#### + Benefits

- Requirements on the RMDCN are changing
  - Increased volumes of product dissemination
  - Evolution of the GTS towards the WIS
- Outcome of the Invitation to Tender (ITT)
  - Interoute Communications Ltd offered best value for money
  - Higher bandwidth for ECMWF Member States
  - Competitive pricing for preferred configurations of all countries

# Project Objectives

- To "realise the migration of the RMDCN from the current provider (OBS) to the new provider (Interoute)...
- "without a break in operational service to currently connected user sites.
- "To migrate as many of the currently connected sites as possible...
- "and to connect as many GISCs as possible."

# \*Contract Milestones

- Contract Schedule 5 lists a set of 14 Project Events
- **■** Four Milestones
  - Liquidated damages if missed
- Three Key Milestones
  - Right to terminate if missed
- Good news: all key milestones were achieved

### **Contract Process**

- Four months of contract selection and negotiation with the selected tenderer(s)
  - Process (service delivery, management, etc)
  - Technical Implementation
  - Service Level Agreement (SLA)
- Interoute selected and recommended to ECMWF committees
- Contract signature on 11 December 2012

# Pilot Network

- Six pilot sites (thank you!)
  - Austria
  - Belgium
  - Bulgaria
  - ECMWF
  - Japan
  - Sweden
- Orders placed by 13 February 2013
- Interoute handover by 26 May 2013

# Pilot Network Acceptance

- Successful Pilot Network acceptance by 30 June 2013
- However... several issues found
  - Process of ordering
  - Communication of technical specifications (DCF)
  - Router installation
  - Router configurations
- Lessons Learned meeting in July 2013
  - Open, honest communication from both sides
  - Extremely valuable for the Initial Deployment!

# **Initial Deployment**

- Orders for 32 ECMWF States submitted by 1 July 2013
- Additional nine Acceding Parties submitted by 12 July
- This becomes the "Intial Deployment"
  - Guaranteed to be migrated with ECMWF
  - Other sites can order, but at a greater risk of gap in service between OBS and Interoute
- 29 sites handed over by 21 November 2013



# Global Network Acceptance

- 60% of Initial Deployment pass Reliability Tests by 19<sup>th</sup> December 2013
- ECMWF accepts the RMDCN-NG and is contractually committed

# Accelerated Incremental Migration

- January 6<sup>th</sup> 2014 one month migration begins
- February 6<sup>th</sup> 2014 migration ends
- Each user site is assigned a day for cut-over of service from OBS to Interoute.
- Several unallocated days at the end of the window
- Each site assigned one member of ECMWF RMDCN team to manage and assist with the migration
- Two sites did not migrate when scheduled, but will be migrated before ECMWF is disconnected from OBS

#### + Current Status

- All OBS sites are now migrated to Interoute service
- Except for:
  - Australia Circuit delivery now in progress
  - Lebanon Still deciding technical configuration
  - Saudi Arabia Order placed with Interoute
  - UAE Order placed with Interoute
  - USA Waiting on local contractor to complete cabling
- ECMWF will disconnect from OBS on 8 May 2014

### Lessons Learned



- Essential to the eventual success of the Initial Deployment and Accelerated Incremental Migration
- Team Meetings
  - Weekly internal meeting at ECMWF
- Supplier Meetings
  - Weekly video conference with Interoute
- Action Tracking
  - Track correspondence with user sites, recent activity, order and deployment status
- User Site Communications
  - Minor issues with culture, language, funding, technical infrastructure
  - Having dedicated ECMWF RMDCN team member per site helped
